ASCAP & BMI Issue Joint Comments To House Judiciary Committee Regarding Reform of the U.S. Copyright Office

Congress has been engaged in a multi-year review of our copyright laws, and recently released the first of many likely legislative proposals to reform the copyright system in the form of a White Paper report issued by the U.S. House Judiciary Committee. This report raises a number of suggestions, including providing the Copyright Office greater autonomy over its general operations (namely budget and technology) and an aggressive plan to modernize the Office through enhanced technology, among other things. It also proposes a plan for the Copyright Office to develop and maintain a centralized database of copyright ownership information.
