ASCAP Comments on U.S. Department of Justice Appeal of BMI Rate Court 100% Licensing Decision to Second Circuit

November 11, 2016 – The American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP) issued the following statement from ASCAP CEO Beth Matthews in response to the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) filing its notice of appeal of the BMI Rate Court's rejection of the government's 100% licensing position: "The Second Circuit's ruling in this case will affect the rights of more than a million American songwriters and composers, thousands of whom have expressed strong opposition to the DOJ's position, and we are hopeful the Court will affirm Judge Stanton's decision. ASCAP looks forward to resolution of this matter as we continue to advocate for modernizing the consent decrees for today's world." [Read full article here](#)
